Ordinary Resolution 3

- (a) The Members approve expenditure by the Club not exceeding \$5,000 until the Annual General Meeting in 2024 for the following expenses subject to approval by the Board of Directors:
 - i. The cost of meals and beverages for each Director at a reasonable time before or after a Board or Committee meeting, on the day of that meeting.

- ii. Reasonable expenses incurred by Directors either within the Club or elsewhere in relation to such other duties including entertainment of special guests of the Club and other promotional activities approved by the Board on production of documentary evidence of such expenditure.
- (b) The Members acknowledge that the benefit in paragraph (a) is not available to Members generally, but only for those who are Directors of the Club.

Ordinary Resolution 4

- (a) The Members approve expenditure by the Club not exceeding \$10,000 until the Annual General Meeting 2024 for professional development and education of Directors over the following 12 months. Including:
 - i. The reasonable cost of Directors attending the Clubs NSW Annual General Meeting.
 - ii. The reasonable cost of Directors attending meetings of other Associations of which the Club is a Member.
 - iii. The reasonable cost of Directors attending seminars, lectures, trade shows/ displays, organised study tours a similar events as may be determined by the Board from time to time.
 - iv. The reasonable cost of Directors attending other Clubs for the purpose of observing their facilities and methods of operation.
 - v. Attendance at functions with spouses where appropriate and required to represent the Club.
- (b) The Members acknowledge that the benefits in paragraph (a) above are not available to Members generally, but only for those who are Directors of the Club.

Ordinary Resolution 5

- (a) The Members approve expenditure by the Club until the Annual General Meeting in 2024 for an honorarium of \$2,740 per Director.
 - i. The honorariums referred to in paragraph (a) be paid by equal monthly downloads onto the Membership card of the Directors receiving the honorariums at the approval of the Board.
- (b) The Members acknowledge that the benefits in paragraph (a) above are not available to Members generally but only those who are Directors of the Club.

Notes

1. To be passed each Ordinary Resolution must receive votes from a simple majority of those Members who are eligible to do so vote in person on the Ordinary Resolution at the Meeting.
2. Life Members and Financial Members re eligible to vote on each of the Ordinary Resolutions.
3. Under the Registered Clubs Act, Members who are employees of the Club are not eligible to vote.
4. Proxy voting is prohibited by the Registered Clubs Act.
5. Each of the Ordinary Resolutions has been proposed by the Board.
